THE DINGLE PENINSULA TOUR

The Ring of Kerry has long been acknowledged by various international publications as one of the most picturesque drives on the planet. Join this unforgettable day tour and you'll soon find out why! The Ring of Kerry is usually done in an anti-clockwise direction along the banks of the River Laune to Killorglin, via Glenbeigh, Kells, Caherciveen and the southern shores of Dingle Bay.The tour continues to Waterville and along the coast via Coomakista Pass and Derrynane and on to Sneem. From Sneem we travel up the mountain road to Molls Gap, then via Ladies View and back to Killarney.

KILLARNEY NATIONAL PARK

The Killarney National Park extends over 25,000 acres and includes the famous Lakes of Killarney and the MacGuillicuddy Reeks, Ireland's highest mountain range. There are so many features to this enormous and striking park that it is impossible to name them all. The focal point for many visitors to Killarney, Muckross House & Gardens has been entertaining as a 19th century mansion, containing all original pieces of furniture, artwork, trophies and many other furnishings from that period. Tours can be booked daily to visit Muckross House & Gardens

Whilst spending a day in Killarney National Park it is worth including visiting Torc Waterfall, an impressive waterfall easily accessed from the road and by walking alongside Dinis Cottage, a historical hunting lodge dating back to the 1700s. It has operated as a tea room for more than 200 years and offers both inside and outdoor seating. It is a tempting stop-off for many visitors walking the popular Muckross and Dinis route through the National Park.
